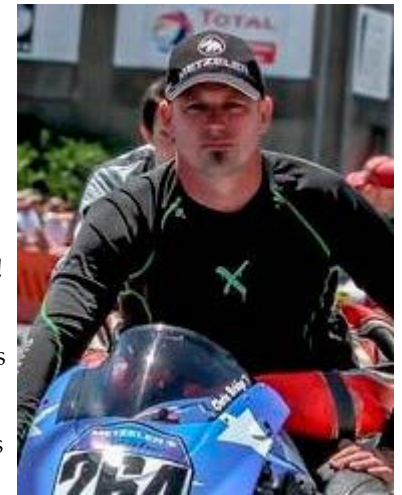

KTM 890 Adventure - Review

Even though the Adventure shares the same engine as the Duke R that I rode last month it feels like a totally different bike. Not that surprising I guess with different engine management, suspension and 21/18inch wheel sizes when compared to the 17/17inch on the Duke. What did surprise me was how competent it was when it was pushed through the corners. Grip could also be further enhanced with road tyres rather than the adventure tyres which are fitted as standard. The standard multi purpose tyres did work well but it was reassuring to know the traction control and ABS were there to help. I cruised South then West towards Raglan and off the tarseal on to some private forestry roads to try the Adventure side of the KTM. It felt good, stable and predictable and changed direction easily. It was slow to pull up but this is not a brake problem as a heavy bike off the seal will always be slow to stop especially with tyres that are

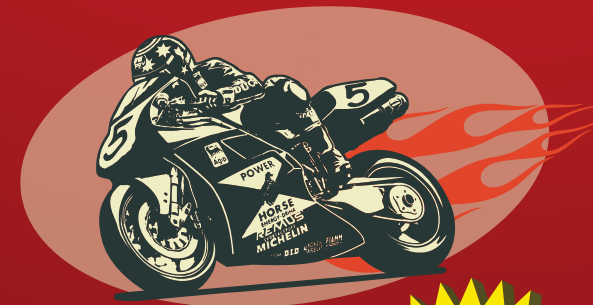

designed for on/off road. Once again the computer is there to help, although you need to be a lot more alert than on the road as it will only assist your riding, it is not going to save you everytime. More of a knobly would be a huge help off road, but then you will compromise your road handling. That is the big dilemma with "On/Off Road" riding, anything that helps one will impact the other. This 890 in my opinion handles this cross over between the two better than the 1200 Adventures or the big singles, but there is no perfect fit. If you are in the market for this type of bike think carefully about the amount of each surface and terrain you intending on riding on. If you are riding to Bluff and sneaking down a few gravel roads on the way go for the 1200s. If circumnavigating the North Island as close to the coast as possible is your goal, you will have an easier time on a big single. That leaves everything inbetween for the mid size Adventures, and the 890 would be a great choice in that category. That could be improved to suit either better with different tyres.

This is only my opinion though.

ROAD RIDERS CORNER

AUGUST

August is a special month for us road riders, we do an annual overnighter Coromandel loop, staying the night there.

Our usual accommodation, Pats Place is no longer available, so we have organised an alternative, BUT WE WONT BE WANDERING OFF TO THE PUB FOR A FEED.

To HMCC Road Riders and friends

Saturday 21 August Coromandel Overnighter Otautu Bay Farm Camp

25 km past Coromandel to Colville

5 km Colville to Otautu Bay ... approx 2 km of gravel

We will hire The Homestead ... has it 11 beds of various configurations. Couples: There are no separate room with just a double bed. So, The Homestead will sleep 11 ... but there are a couple of double beds for those who wish share. (Otherwise, see Unit below)

- **They supply bottom sheet, pillow and pillow case. Bring own top sheet and blanket(s) or sleeping bag.**
- **Booking/deposit for Homestead:** The Club has paid the \$240, and all those that stay will be expected to pay their share - \$25-40 depending on how full. If the ride is cancelled because it's too wet, we can reschedule a later weekend the house is available.
- **Food & drink:** We will need to take our own food and drink. The last stop for such is Colville. It is possible someone may drive their car/van, in which case this may be able to carry supplies. To be confirmed later and then details worked out. If not, pack on the bikes.
- **Additonal space: The Unit**
There is a separate Unit ... has one bedroom with a double bed & bunks. They supply bottom sheet, pillow and pillow case. Bring own top sheet and blanket(s) or sleeping bag.
\$160 for the night. Kitchen and cutlery supplied.
If there's an immediate overflow of more than 11 people going, then an overflow could go into to the separate unit, if it's available. It's available as of today, but ... This could be used by a couple that wants their own space.
So, for the Unit - first in, first served. The sooner we know, the sooner it won't be booked by someone else entirely !!!
- **Booking: The first 11 beds are filling fast!**
We won't book the extra Unit until we have a confirmed overflow of 11, OR, if a couple wants it. IF IT IS AVAILABLE,
So, the sooner we have riders confirmed, the sooner we can secure the Unit if it is wanted/needed.
- **Camping**
Yes, if you don't want a room in the Homestead or the Unit, you can sleep in a tent !

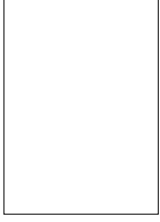
