### October Presidents Report

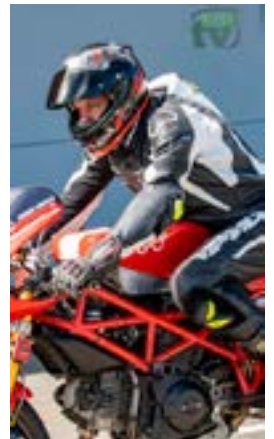
Hello fellow Bikers.

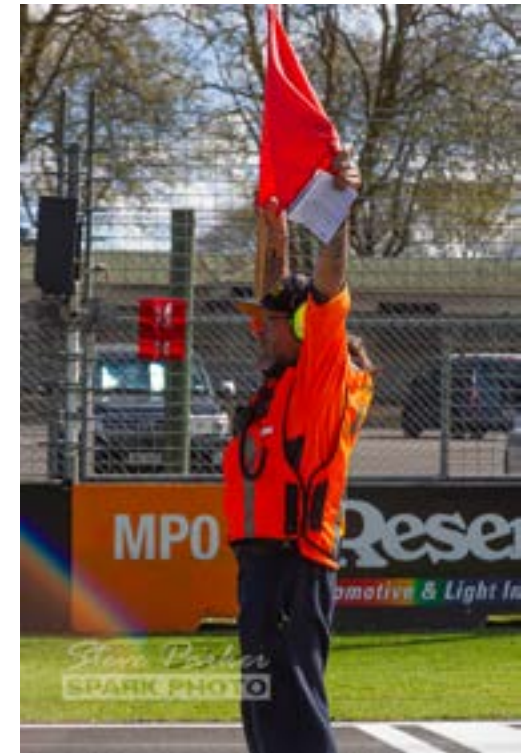

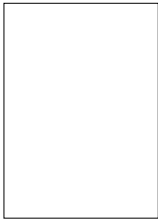
